Bethel Community Outreach Ministries is a registered Non-Governmental Organization, (INDR7213581B) based in Greater Masaka. We work towards touching lives and transforming communities in Uganda through the love of Jesus Christ. The organisation runs a private primary and Nursery school where needy children access free education. We also reach out to rural areas of Greater Masaka, where people share dirty water with animals. These are areas where government has failed to provide clean water, so our purpose is to improve the health of children and adults through providing safe drinking water by manually drilling boreholes. We also support local pastors and churches in their work of ministry through setting up church structures

• Provision of education to orphans and needy children



child sponsorship per month is £20

The organisation runs a project school of over 260 needy children through child sponsorship. helping a needy child to access education for a year takes £240

• Feed my Lamb project

We reach out to hungry families in our community with food packs.

Most people in Uganda live by hand to mouth, and due to scanty rains hunger and starvation is common

We have reached out and provided food packs to over 200 families in our community!



• Wells of Life project

A vast number of rural communities in Uganda share water with animals from ponds thus causing health issues to little children and adults.

over the years, we have reached out to several village communities manually drilling boreholes!

Desiring to put a smile on an entire village community needs 3000GBP only for community well!



One of the challenges we face with manual drilling is; breaking hard rocks, loss of oxygen at deeper depths before we hit a water table. We are believing God for a water driller machine!

• Lasting Impact - Uganda (support for local Pastors and churches)

We focus on training local pastors as many have not got an opportunity to attend a Bible school. We desire to raise men and women of integrity. We also reach out to help at raising structures! some churches fellowship under trees!
